TIP SHEET FOR HOMESCHOOL FUNDING REIMBURSEMENT

- Funding per student is \$901. Parents who submit receipts for 75% of the \$901 will receive the entire amount. Kindergarten students will receive \$450.50.
- Parents have up to 2 years to access homeschool funding. Last year's unused funding will be placed into your account for use with this year's expenses.
- Reimbursements are processed from October 15th to May 31st each year. Submit early to avoid end of year deadline issues and receipt problems. (\$100 minimum per claim).
- Please indicate the student's name for which the item/lessons/activity is for on claim form or receipt.
- Do not write out each item if already listed on a receipt write a general description and the sum total Amount of the receipt. Don't use a separate claim form for individual students.
- Please provide a note explaining *unusual* purchases/activities and relevancy to course.

<u>Consumables</u> (pencils, paper, ink cartridges, art supplies, etc.) are claimable for receipts dated from July 1, 2023 and onwards for current school year.

<u>Curriculum resources</u> and books <u>that are specifically for the 2023-2024 school year</u> are claimable for receipts dated January 1, 2023 and onwards for the current school year.

<u>Proof of exchange rate</u> is required for purchases made out of Canada (*copy of credit card statement or historical exchange rate printout for exact date.*) Just writing it in on claim without proof is not sufficient.

<u>Technology</u> purchases dated Jan. 1, 2023 and onwards are claimable for 2023-2024. Each student can claim \$500 maximum/year. A family with more than one student can use their technology amounts towards one large purchase. (Warranties/protection plans/fax machines are not reimbursable).

Computer headphones maximum claimable is \$75.

<u>Internet</u> monthly service fees are claimable from September 2023 to August 2024 at 50% of monthly cost. <u>A bill/invoice is required for each and every month claimed</u>. Installation is not claimable.

Lessons: Costs are claimable from Sept. 2023 to June 2024.

- "Lessons" must be training/technique rather than a registration to join a sport or competitions.
- If a variety of educational activities are done through a <u>homeschool group</u>, please provide detail of program activities.
- Also send in a Certification of Qualifications form for the instructor(s) if activity is not with a registered association/facility/pool/college/university, etc.

Not claimable: soccer, curling, hockey, football, baseball, wallclimbing

Admissions/fieldtrips/science centres/recreation centres/workshops costs:

50% of funding maximum (\$450.50). Claimable from Sept. 2023 to June 2024.

Other claimable items:

Educational apps; library membership; computer repairs; educational games (provide detail); music books; music instruments/rentals (50% of funding max.); gym equipment/rentals (similar to what is provided in schools - 50% funding max.), science supplies, cameras, telescopes.

Home Ec.: supplies/lessons/sewing machine for grades 5-12 (\$50% of funding = \$450.50 maximum)

Items not claimable:

Parent admission costs, travel costs, furniture, postage, phone calls, insurance, HSLDA, homeschool group memberships, RCM exams, clothing/uniforms, competitions/festivals; AGF fees; driving lessons, backpacks, gift coupons/certificates redeemed; phys.ed. equipment not provided in schools.
